Scripture(s): *Malachi 1:11*

The promotion of His name for His glory is the driving force behind the true missions of the Church.

**Topic:** *Moral Purity*

**Scripture(s):** *Song Of Solomon 4:8*

**Description:** Paul Washer argues that the Song Of Solomon is more than just a book about the relationship between a man and a woman, and he uses these verses to expound aspects of the church's living relationship with Christ. It is easy to learn principles about holiness, he says, but how much time do we spend in the presence of Christ? As Martin Lloyd Jones warned, our lives will become nothing but a bunch of cold principles if the presence and power of God is not in our life.

**Topic:** *Motivation*

**Scripture(s):** *Isaiah 43:6*

**Description:** Brother Paul Washer here describes the true motivation to living in holiness, as well as the motivation that should permeate every other aspect of our lives. After destroying the presupposition that has infiltrated our thinking, that there are "great men of God", Brother Paul then bursts out of the gate to show us that all that matters is the glory of God, and we must be motivated in every aspect of our lives to that one singular end.
